



## Literacy Minute: Make a Book



Work together to make your own story book!

Start simple with young children – have them draw or tape pictures, one on each page, then write the name of the object below the picture.

Older children may be able to choose a character and describe some activities for that character. Draw pictures and write out the words of the story together.

To make a photo book, tape or glue pictures of different people and write who they are above or below their photo. Include pictures of grandma, grandpa, aunts, uncles, mom, dad, siblings, friends or anyone else special to your family.

### Supplies you will need:

- Paper, folded in half
- String, tape or staples to hold the pages together
- Crayons, markers, paint or pictures cut out from magazines
